### Many Inputs Affect Shelter Cats' Well-being



- Housing quality
- Facility design, use, maintenance
- Population management, Length of stay (crowding)
- Staffing capacity (time and skills)
- Assessment and care for medical and behavioral needs
- Sanitation and biosecurity
- Intake/outcome policies (barriers)
- Community engagement and support
- And so much more...







Freedom from discomfort










As we follow Skittle's journey and explore what makes good cat cage housing, we'll use this slider.

The best housing for pet cats is a home, but we can provide good <u>short-term</u> housing that meets cats' needs in the shelter environment.





### Every Cat Is an Individual


Each cat experiences fear, anxiety, stress, and length of shelter stay differently.



### Variety of Housing Types


It's important to have a variety of housing types to better meet individuals' needs.



### **Double Compartment Cage Housing**



Reduces cats' stress

Reduces disease in individual & population (stress→ URI)



Double compartment housing = minimal handling



Staff safety (scratch/bite reduction)

Staff efficiency of daily care & cleaning






## Cats individually housed: 11 ft<sup>2</sup> floor space\*

- Width ≥ 30", depth 28"(--> Diagonal 41")
- Height: 28-30"

Cats can posture normally in litterbox, scratch, stretch out, retreat, say hi, etc




## **Angie Asks for Portals**





Angie isn't giving up yet. She's found some low-cost ways to improve shelter cats' cages.















## Things You Can Do Now

## Cage Furnishings and Set-Up




There's a lot you and Angie can do to make shelter cats happier with a few small changes.

#### **IMPORTANT NOTE:**



## Day 13 Skittles Goes Home!


With all the great changes Angie made to cat housing, Skittles has been playful and happy, and recovered quickly from her URI.

Not only is kitten season in full swing, but the shelter has adopted out more this year compared to last year!


